

ORDINANCE NO. 767 of 2021

BOROUGH OF LEMOYNE CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A NEW TRUST ACCOUNT FOR THE DEPOSIT OF FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Lemoyne, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, and **IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Lemoyne has received funding, and anticipates receiving additional funding from the Federal government under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for the performance of certain activities as authorized by ARPA.

Section 2. In order that the Borough is better able to track the income and expenses related to the ARPA funds and projects funded thereby, Borough Council, pursuant to the authority granted under Section 1313.1 of the Borough Code, by vote taken at a duly constituted meeting on August 5, 2021, authorized the creation of a new trust account for the deposit of the ARPA funds.

Section 3. Council further authorized that any ARPA funds that may have already been received by the Borough and deposited into the General Fund account, be withdrawn from the General Fund account and placed into this newly created ARPA account.

Section 4. Provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and if any part of any Section or provision thereof shall be held unconstitutional, illegal, or otherwise invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining Sections, parts of Sections, or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared the legislation intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or otherwise invalid portions not been included herein.
