



## **Borough Manager's Report**

### **July 7, 2022**

- The Comprehensive Recreation Parks & Open Space (CRPOS) Study Committee continues to meet on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month using the Zoom platform. PASHEK-MTR handles all meeting logistics, and all meetings are open to the public.
- Council President Gallo, Councilmember Koontz, Code Enforcement Officer Rafferty and I attended the Greater Harrisburg Association of Realtors municipal breakfast on June 21<sup>st</sup>. This annual event included an update from the Harrisburg Regional Chamber and CREDC.
- I submitted our Cumberland County Recovery Grant application on June 20<sup>th</sup> for stormwater remediation on Walnut from Fort to North Third and on North Third from Walnut to Market. If successful the project includes stormwater piping, installation of rain gardens, and a porous paving application on the section of Poplar between North Third and the dead end.
- We met with representatives from the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission to discuss grant opportunities. We will be pursuing a Regional Transportation Grant for streetscape improvements on Third Street from Market to the bridge closest to Lowther Street. These improvements will tie into proposed improvements in the Bottleneck as well as future plans Penn DOT may have to replace that bridge. Deadline to apply is July 31.
- Staffing update:
  - We are in the process of hiring an MS4 Coordinator and expect the appointment to be made at the July 21<sup>st</sup> Business Meeting.
  - I received notice of another staff retirement. Terry Fasick in the Maintenance Department will be leaving us on July 8<sup>th</sup> after more than 40 years of service to the community. We wish him well as he starts this next chapter of his life.
