

Borough Manager's Report May 5, 2022

- The Comprehensive Recreation Parks & Open Space (CRPOS) Study Committee
 continues to meet on the 3rd Tuesday of each month using the Zoom platform. PASHEKMTR is handling the logistics, and all meetings are open to the public. The next meeting
 is scheduled for May 17th which is election day; I look for the meeting to be rescheduled.
 Information will be posted to the website as soon as the date is confirmed.
- I've submitted the compliance report required under the American Rescue Plan Act by the April 30th deadline.
- Staff participated in a Green Light Go grant kick-off meeting to discuss the project to upgrade our traffic signals on Third Street. Penn DOT is taking the lead on design; we will be meeting again in the coming weeks to move the project forward.
- I also submitted the progress report required under the Green Light Go Grant program by the April 30th deadline.
- The Maintenance Superintendent/MS4 Coordinator met with representatives from the Environmental Protection Agency for an inspection of our stormwater facilities. There were a few minor corrections that were made and reported back to the EPA. We also successfully completed a similar inspection with PA Department of Environmental Protection a few weeks ago.
- I have resubmitted an application to FEMA for a second look at our reimbursement request for expenses related to COVID that were denied during the first round of funding. If successful we should see about \$20,000 returned to our coffers for expenses incurred during the pandemic.
- We received our dividend check in the amount of \$18,018.78 this past month from MRM, our property and casualty insurance provider. We've been receiving these checks annually for the last few years now.
