



Borough Manager's Report

May 5, 2022

- The Comprehensive Recreation Parks & Open Space (CRPOS) Study Committee continues to meet on the 3rd Tuesday of each month using the Zoom platform. PASHEK-MTR is handling the logistics, and all meetings are open to the public. The next meeting is scheduled for May 17th which is election day; I look for the meeting to be rescheduled. Information will be posted to the website as soon as the date is confirmed.
- I've submitted the compliance report required under the American Rescue Plan Act by the April 30th deadline.
- Staff participated in a Green Light Go grant kick-off meeting to discuss the project to upgrade our traffic signals on Third Street. Penn DOT is taking the lead on design; we will be meeting again in the coming weeks to move the project forward.
- I also submitted the progress report required under the Green Light Go Grant program by the April 30th deadline.
- The Maintenance Superintendent/MS4 Coordinator met with representatives from the Environmental Protection Agency for an inspection of our stormwater facilities. There were a few minor corrections that were made and reported back to the EPA. We also successfully completed a similar inspection with PA Department of Environmental Protection a few weeks ago.
- I have resubmitted an application to FEMA for a second look at our reimbursement request for expenses related to COVID that were denied during the first round of funding. If successful we should see about \$20,000 returned to our coffers for expenses incurred during the pandemic.
- We received our dividend check in the amount of \$18,018.78 this past month from MRM, our property and casualty insurance provider. We've been receiving these checks annually for the last few years now.
