

Lemoyne Municipal Authority – Summary Report to Council

August 9, 2022 Meeting

General:

During public comment I gave an update on council discussion on the Water Quality Management permit condition related to elimination of on-lot systems. I relayed that a review of our ordinances appears to indicate they are adequate. We may need to develop a revised plan for compliance. I indicated that Bob Oakes, Cindy Foster, and I have a meeting scheduled to discuss next steps. LMA will be kept informed and solicited for input.

Operators Report:

Discharge limits for phosphorus were exceeded again in July but are now in compliance. On-line monitors have been added to allow faster responses to upsets.

Still waiting on parts for the installation of new digester diffusers. The supplier has found a new source.

Busy with on-lot inspections. One system failed testing this week.

One employee has been terminated and hiring initiated for their replacement.

Engineer activities for prior month:

The UV equipment shop drawings have been submitted and are under review. Final design is continuing with a target to advertise for bids in mid-October. A funding application for the project was submitted to the County ARPA program.
