Operators Report:

Received a notice of violation for high fecal coliform related to high flows and chlorine system issues in September

The new gate at the WWTP is installed and operational

The centrifuge operations have been optimized

Johnston Construction found and fixed a leak on the piping at the Clark St Pump Station, under warranty

A search is underway to fill the vacancy in the department

Engineer activities for prior month:

The NPDES permit renewal is complete and ready for execution and submission to DEP

The Water Quality Management permit for the new UV system is ready for execution and submission to DEP

The annual report for the Chesapeake Bay was completed and submitted

A submission for pretreatment system by Mid-State Carpet was reviewed and rejected

Treasurers Report:

Will Hesse requested the Engineer provide a list of improvements with costs for the 2022 LMA budget

There were questions and discussion related to the amount of tapping fees collected in 2021 and expected in 2022 which led to questions related to the adequacy of the fee and the policy for existing buildings being repurposed

The budget will be reviewed at the December meeting and approved in January.
