

Some of you may have read the article in Tuesday's Patriot News regarding staffing difficulties at area swimming pools. Todd Miller was quoted regarding staffing at the Lemoyne pool and echoed the concerns of other pool managers.

I reached out to Todd on Tuesday, and here is his update:

"I am in a much better situation now than when I gave that information to the reporter from Penn Live. I was able to hire 3 additional lifeguards from a certification class that we just finished and one of my managers from last year changed their mind and decided to return for one more season!

Yes, we are currently able to staff the pool for the hours listed. I have completed the schedule through June 30 at this point so we should be good as long as multiple people do not get sick or injured etc. Limiting admission to season pass holders and guests only is the key to being able to adequately staff the pool at this time. Walk-ins would have completely overwhelmed us yesterday (Memorial Day).

Other programs are doing well and registrations continue to come in as school is winding down and people are realizing they need to schedule something for their kids."
