1. Call to Order

The Authority met in regular session at 6:00 p.m. over Zoom. All Authority members were present along with the Authority engineer Mike Knouse and Solicitors Lisa and Robert Coyne. The Plant Manager and Borough Manager and Councilman Gene Koontz were present. John Frey and Garrett Moore of Public Financial Management was also in attendance.

2. Approval of Minutes

3a. PFM Financial Advisors LLC - Debt Restructuring

PFM said they are ready to move at the pace of the LMA. They wanted to know if the LMA is ok with them using "Note Council" that PFM normally uses, Jonathan Cox. That discussion will be resumed at the end of the meeting. Chairman Carroll noted that we hadn't seen a proposal with fees yet. PFM stated that they estimate the cost of their services would be about \$25,000 and that amount is already baked into the cost estimate the LMA received. PFM will only bill us if the LMA uses them to refinance.

Will Hesse made a motion to authorize PFM to move forward with the RFP contingent on an agreed to engagement letter between the LMA and PFM. Dennis McGee seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Will Hesse made a motion to proceed with option 3a as reflected in May 12, 2020 presentation given by PFM which involves a \$500,000 cash contribution from the LMA in order to shorten the life of the debt. Pete Shuntich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Gene Koontz thanked the LMA for giving the Council a heads up on the refinancing plans. None of council members objected to the Authority pursuing refinancing options.

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Plant is in good shape. There are no effluent violations.

5. Engineer's Report
