## Parks and Recreation Committee

### Minutes of the Meeting held on September 8, 2014

#### 1. Call to Order

Meeting of the Parks and Recreation Committee of Lemoyne Borough Council was held on Monday, September 8, 2014 at the Lemoyne Borough Office, 510 Herman Avenue, Lemoyne, PA. Chairwoman Donna Hope called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

#### 2. Roll Call

Committee members David Beasley and Brenda Candioto were present. Staff present was Jim Fair.

#### 3. Public Comments

There were no public comments.

#### 4. Review of the Minutes from the Last Meeting

The minutes from the meeting held July 14, 2014 was completed and the minutes were approved as amended with a motion by Mr. Beasley, seconded by Mrs. Candioto and a unanimous vote in favor of passage.

#### 5. Old Business

- a. Update on dog park – Mayor York offered a presentation on the Scout Project to make Frasier Park a dog friendly park. An initial phase concept plan was discussed and the Committee agreed to have Mr. Fair check into the use of the park for open space requirements. It was decided the ordinance to permit dogs in the park would need to be amended to include Frasier Park. Mr. Beasley made a motion to recommend Council approval of the initial design of the park changes and have the Solicitor draft the needed ordinance change. Mrs. Candioto seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous for passage of the motion.

#### 6. New Business

- a. Cost to remove trees at Negley Park – Mr. Fair shared the initial plan to remove 6 trees at a cost of \$1, 520 if completed in October or November for a cost of \$1,285 if completed in December, January or February. There was discussion with the company about 4 large Ash Trees that are likely going to become rotted soon. The Committee asked Mr. Fair to gather additional quotes for next month.
- b. Cost to repair and repave the tennis court/basketball court at Memorial Park – Mr. Fair has not yet completed gathering the quotes for this project and will have more information next month.
