Streets and Stormwater Committee January 13, 2014

1. Call to Order: The Streets and Parking Committee of the Lemoyne Borough Council were called to order on Monday December 9, 2013 at 5:00 p.m. with Dennis McGee presiding.
2. Roll Call: Present at roll call was Dennis McGee, Chairperson and Committee member David Beasley. Visitors present were Roi Baptiste, Stacy Gromlich, and Patty Beasley. Robert Ihlein, Borough Manager and John Paden, Maintenance Department Supervisor was also present.
3. Public Comments: Ms. Gromlich suggested for the COG to look into regional storm water authority.
4. Old Business:

STREETS:

- a. Market Street Improvements Phase 2: Mr. Ihlein reported TPD will design the meter base for the new street lights.
- b. Traffic signals 3: 2013 automatic red light enforcement (ARLE) grants - left turn signals at 12th and Market Streets [grant application still pending] – There has been no information from the State about this program in over a year so it will be removed from the agenda for now.
- c. Phrase I crosswalks – Mr. Ihlein will speak to Mr. Cassidy.
- d. I-83 highway improvement project: Mr. McGee asked Mr. Paden about the sidewalks. Mr. Paden stated the sidewalks will be in the final phrase.
- e. Request for a stop sign at 12th Street and Lemoyne Drive: Mr. Ihlein will response with a letter back to the owners on the concerns.
Bosler Avenue Repaving - Mr. Paden will speak to Pennsylvania American Water Company on the repaving of Bosler Avenue from Third to Ninth Street.
- f. Engineer Firm – Ms. Gromlich recommends issuing a RFP for proposals on engineering. Mr. Beasley recommends issuing a RFP for proposals from engineering firms. Mr. McGee seconds the recommendation. All were in favor.

STORM WATER:

- a. Cumberland County Planning Department efforts to coordinate municipal requirements in the MS4 permits for continuing public education and outreach: Mr. Ihlein reported the county has a new website for the MS4. The website will help with the educational requirements.

- b. Other Requirements under the MS4 Permit – Mr. Ihlein reported ARRO is working on a Proposal for Professional Services needed to comply with the Permit requirements. The proposal from ARRO is \$4,000. Mr. Ihlein reported a new requirement for the MS-4. . Chesapeake Bay Pollutant Reduction Plan – Mr. Ihlein presented a proposal from ARRO to write a Plan as required by PADEP. The cost is \$2,500. The committee tabled the proposal unit 2014 for further consideration.
- c. Maple and Walton Streets drainage project (2013 PRIORITY #2): Mr. Paden stated EK Service is waiting for shop drawings from ARRO.
- d. Possible changes to the rain gardens on Market Street built during Phase 1 - This project can be removed from the agenda now.
- e. Ayer Avenue Pond – Mr. Ihlein is working with JVH Excavating. ARRO is working on a Proposal for Professional Services to perform surveying and description of drainage easements that will be needed. The committee recommends talking with the property owners.
- f. Norfolk Southern Water Issues – Mr. Ihlein is waiting for a proposal from ARRO.
- g. Storm Water Ordinance – Mr. Ihlein recommends getting a proposal from ARRO for updating the ordinance.

5. New Business

STREETS:

- a. Salt Brine Tank – Mr. Paden will present an estimated cost for a brine system next month.

STORM WATER:

- a. Chesapeake Bay Pollutant Reduction Plan – Mr. Ihlein presented a proposal from ARRO to write a Plan as required by PADEP. The cost is \$2,500. The committee tabled the proposal unit 2014 for further consideration.
