Streets and Stormwater Committee February 10, 2014

1. Call to Order: The Streets and Parking Committee of the Lemoyne Borough Council were called to order on Monday February 10, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. with Dennis McGee presiding.
2. Roll Call: Present at roll call was Dennis McGee, Chairperson and Committee member David Beasley. Visitors present were Roi Baptiste, Stacy Gromlich, Phillip Brath, Keri Ann Shimp, Gary Bersford, and Patty Beasley. Robert Ihlein, Borough Manager and John Paden, Maintenance Department Supervisor was also present.
3. Public Comments: David Beasley discussed the trash cans in the White Oak area. Ms. Gromlich presented a concern on the traffic signal at Third and Lowther Street. Mr. Paden will contact the Borough's vendor. Ms. Gromlich discussed the concerns on snow plowing and the sidewalks along N. Ninth Street. Ms. Shimp from Hummel Avenue spoke on the parking issues with the snow and ice.

- a. Act 68 – Storm Water Incorporation – Mr. Ihlein spoken on an Authority for local storm water.
- b. Market Street Improvement – Phase 2 lights – Mr. Paden stated the meter base was not approved by PPL. The contractor is working on the meter base.
- c. Phrase I crosswalks – Mr. Ihlein will speak to Mr. Cassidy.
- d. I-83 highway improvement project: Mr. McGee asked Mr. Paden about the sidewalks. Mr. Paden stated the sidewalks will be in the final phrase.
- e. Request for a stop sign at 12th Street and Lemoyne Drive: Mr. Ihlein will response with a letter back to the owners on the concerns.
- f. Bosler Avenue Repaving - Mr. Paden will speak to Pennsylvania American Water Company on the repaving of Bosler Avenue from Third to Ninth Street.
- g. Engineer Firm – Mr. McGee made a recommendation to develop a RFP for the Engineer Firm.
- h. Traffic signals 3: 2013 automatic red light enforcement (ARLE) grants - left turn signals at 12th and Market Streets [grant application still pending] – There has been no information from the State about this program in over a year so it will be removed from the agenda for now.

- i. Salt Brine System – Mr. Paden is working on the estimated cost of the system.
